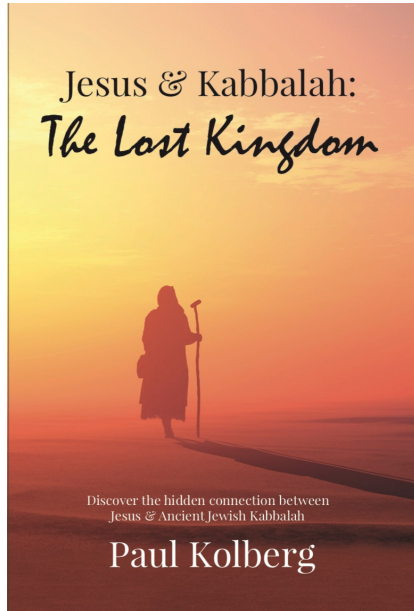

About the book:

The phrase *Kingdom of God* or *Kingdom of Heaven* is not found anywhere in the Jewish Torah, yet it is mentioned over fifty times in the New Testament.
